



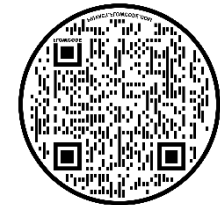
# BE FAIR WITH YOUR CLIMATE PROMISE

Fairtrade farmers are challenging political leaders at the COP 26 UN Climate Summit to:

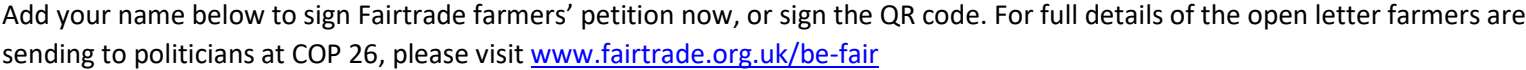
- Ensure that the \$100 billion per year they pledged to tackle a changing climate reaches those who need it most
