


FAIRTRADE REMAINS ESSENTIAL TO UNIVERSITIES DESPITE DISRUPTION TO ACADEMIC YEAR

STUDENT-LED AUDIT

"In interviews I can talk about actually having some experience in auditing and understanding sustainability in practice, rather than just in theory from my degree."

"I think it's made me realise that sustainability really can be applied to any context - whether in a lab or a students' union context to offices." "I think it will have a somewhat positive impact on my employability because, as well as becoming more competent at carrying out an audit professionally, I also developed other key skills valued by employers, such as teamwork, time management, and confidence in interviews."
