Rural communities across Africa, Latin America, Asia and the Pacific are seeing the worst effects of climate change, despite doing the least to cause the climate crisis. These are often the same communities unable to earn enough for their essentials due to unfair trade.

At COP26, the UK government restated a commitment to double funding for communities in low-income countries, as they work to adapt to climate change that is already causing serious hardship.

This funding is good news, but it will only be effective if ministers start delivering on these commitments as soon as possible, and listen to those communities with first-hand knowledge and expertise of taking on the climate crisis. We know Fairtrade farmers already doing vital work – like reforestation, spreading the word on climate-smart farming and protecting biodiversity. This funding could hugely scale up this work.
